

3 Patient Banner

When you select a patient by clicking on the folder before their name, the **Patient Demographics** screen displays.

You can now see the webPAS menu at the Patient Level.



Left Side of the Patient Banner



The folder before the patient's name will only be red if the patient is a Non NZ Resident. Click on the folder to take you to the demographics



Each icon after the patient's name is an active link and has specific meaning



Patient has Alerts / National Medical Warnings.



Patient has a clinical record that can be tracked.



Patient requires the assistance of an interpreter.



The patient has an active referral for outpatients



The patient has been admitted with a Mental Health Legal Status



The patient's BMI has been entered.

BMI Obese

1 Patient NHI Search

The process for searching occurs in 3 stages and progresses to the next if the patient is not found.

1. Local Search
2. National NHI Search (download NHI to webPAS)
3. Patient Registration (restricted access).

Local Search

In some modules, the Local Patient Search screen will be the default home page or alternatively;

At the Hospital Level, go to the Searches tab and select Patient NHI.



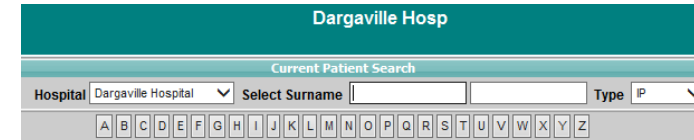
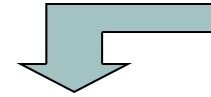
Business Rule Alert

Search information must be adequate to complete a thorough search. For a known NHI, you must still search by name to accurately identify the person attached to the NHI.

If two or more NHI's are found for the patient contact the Merging Clerk.

2 Current Patient Search

At the Hospital Level, go to the Searches tab and this time select Current Patient.



Choose the Hospital or All Hospitals

Enter patient surname or part surname.

Select patient type.

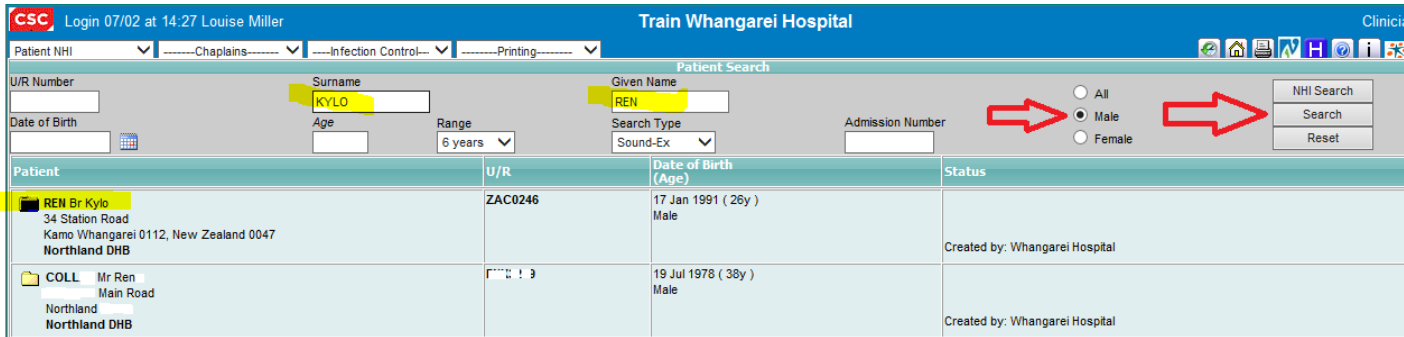
All

OP: Current patient in an Outpatient Clinic

IP: Current inpatient

RF/COM: Current patient with a Referral



Click on the patient folder to open that patient. The patient's demographic details will display.

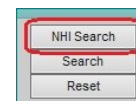


Clicking the **Reset** button clears all boxes.

Name order is unimportant—variations in name order are done by webPAS



if you have not found the patient you are looking for, proceed to a National search, using the NHI Search Button.
